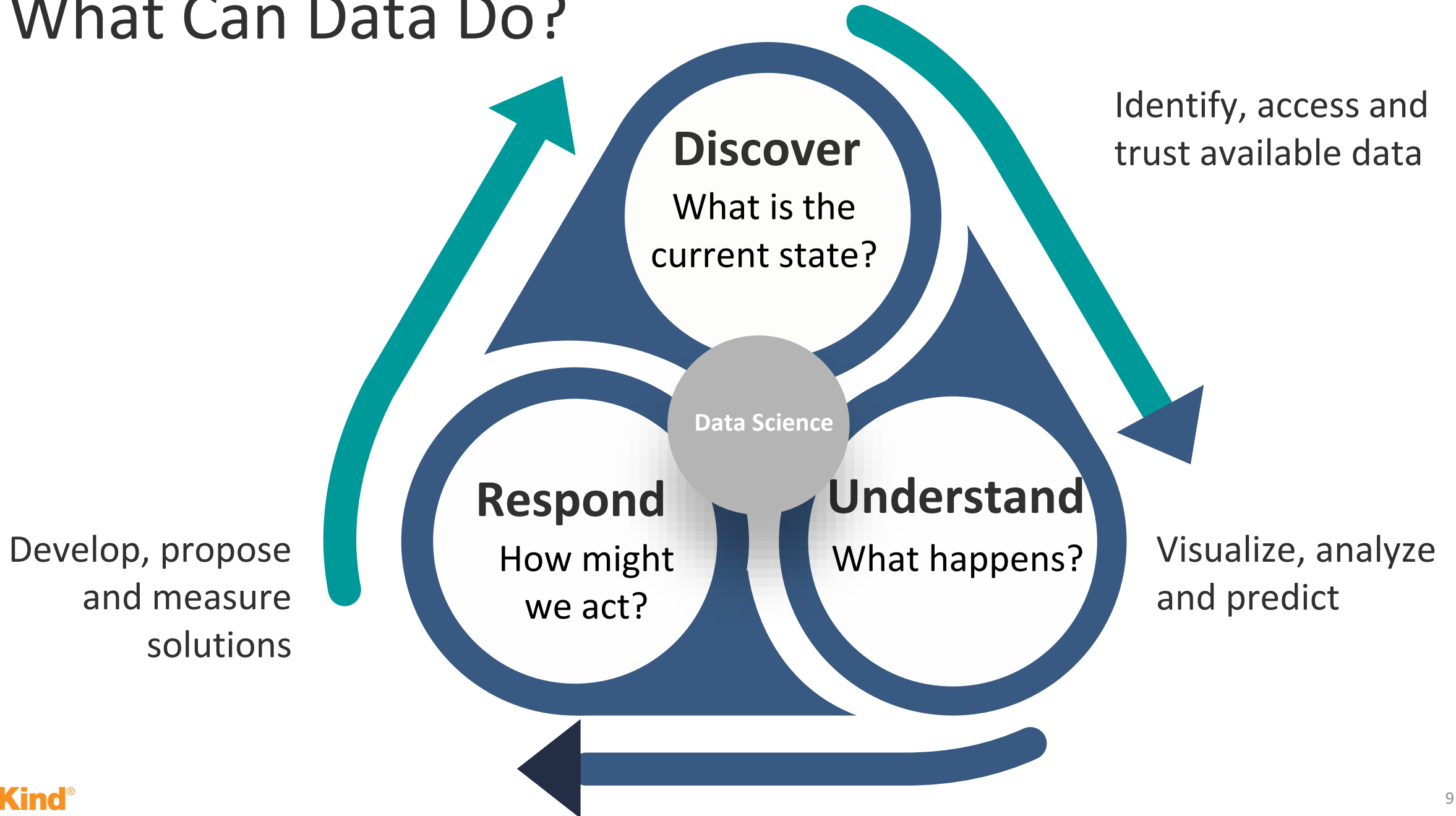

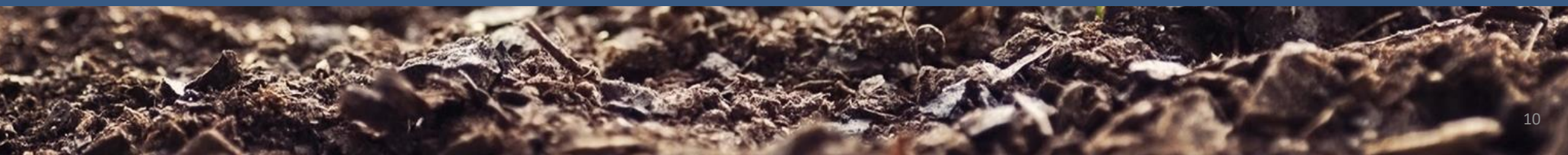

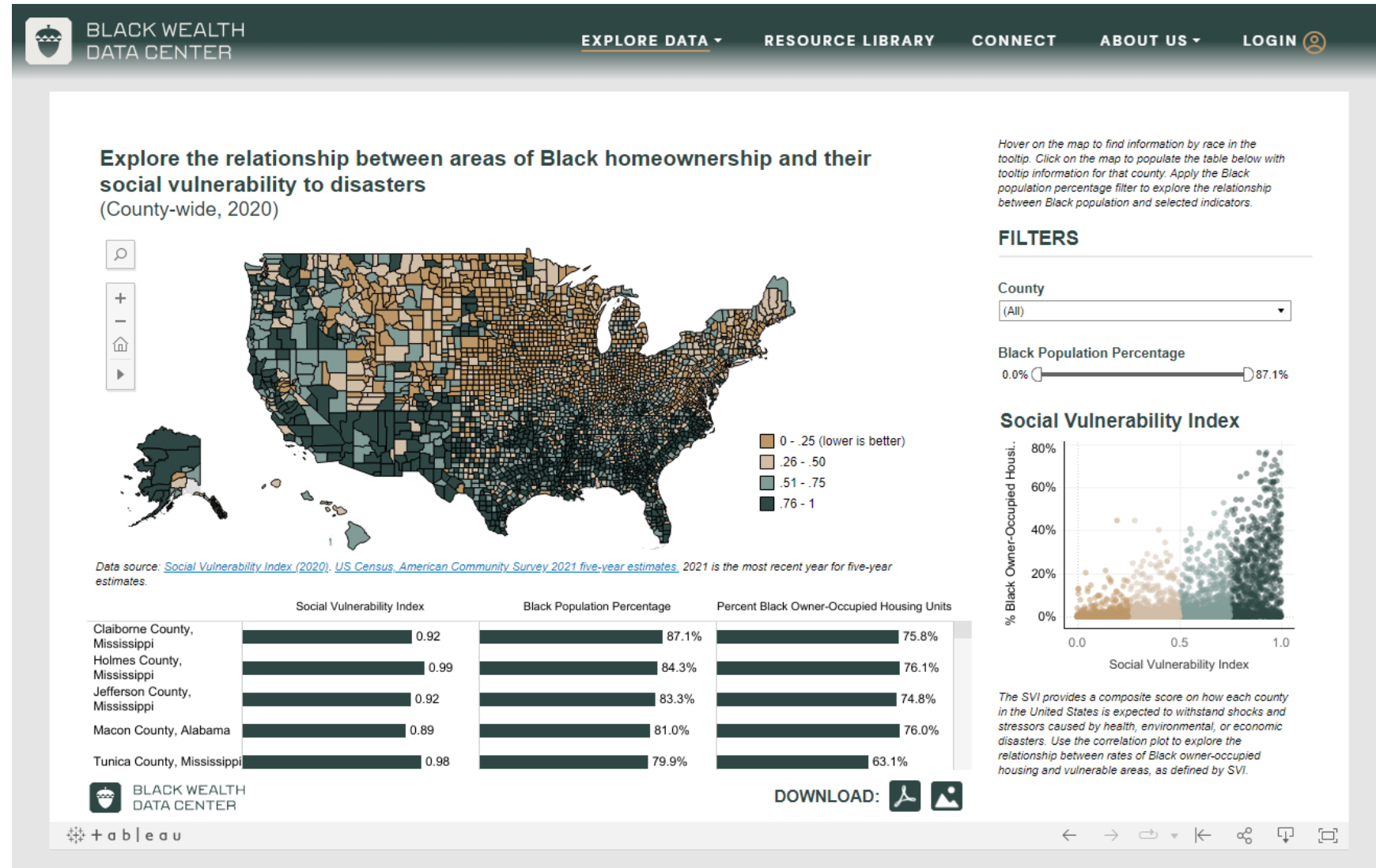
Empowering Decision-Makers

Empowers decision-makers with reliable data to increase generational wealth and combat chronic underinvestment.





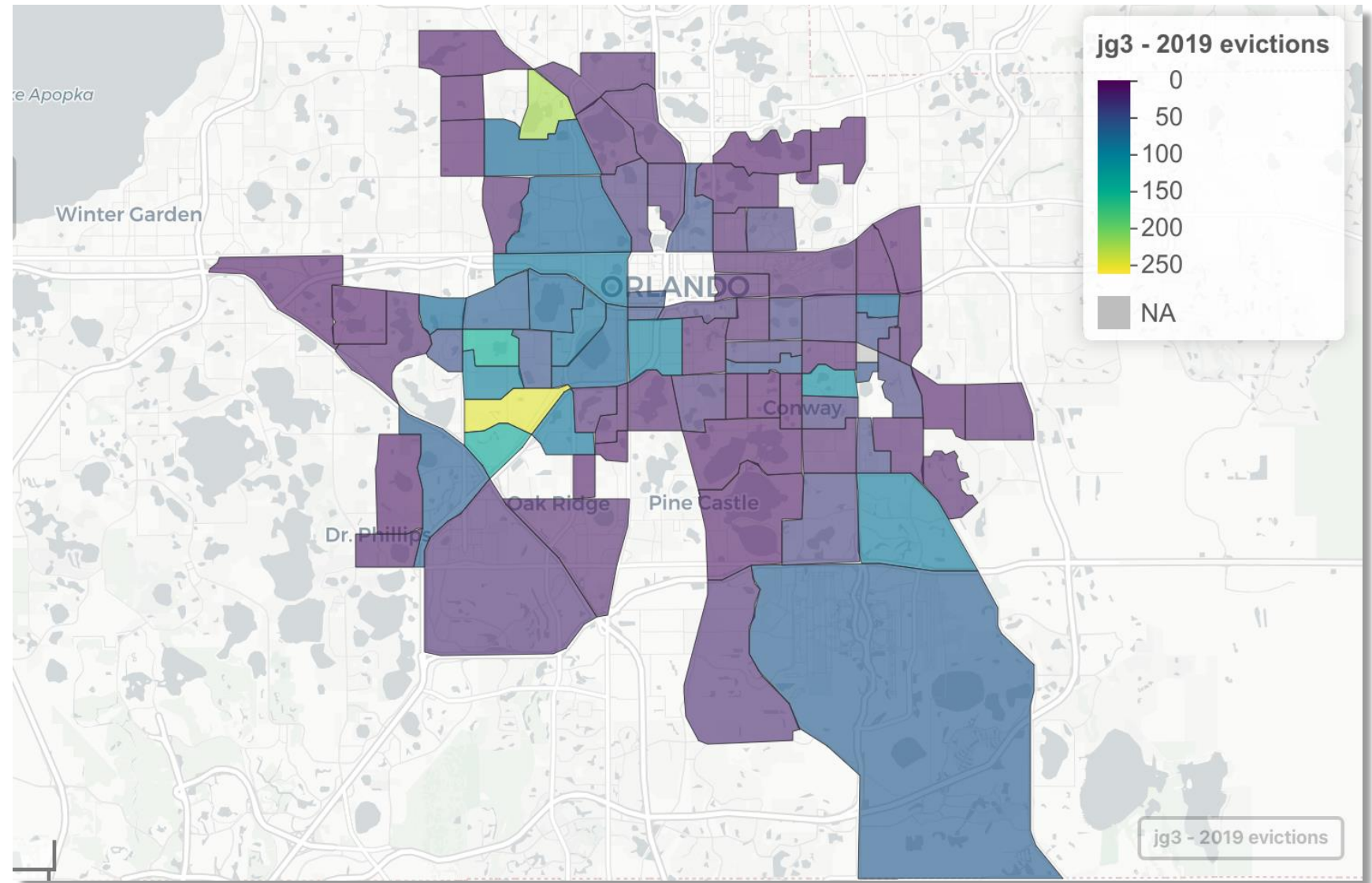
Assessing Community Needs

Mapping analyzing evictions in Orlando, FL for 2019

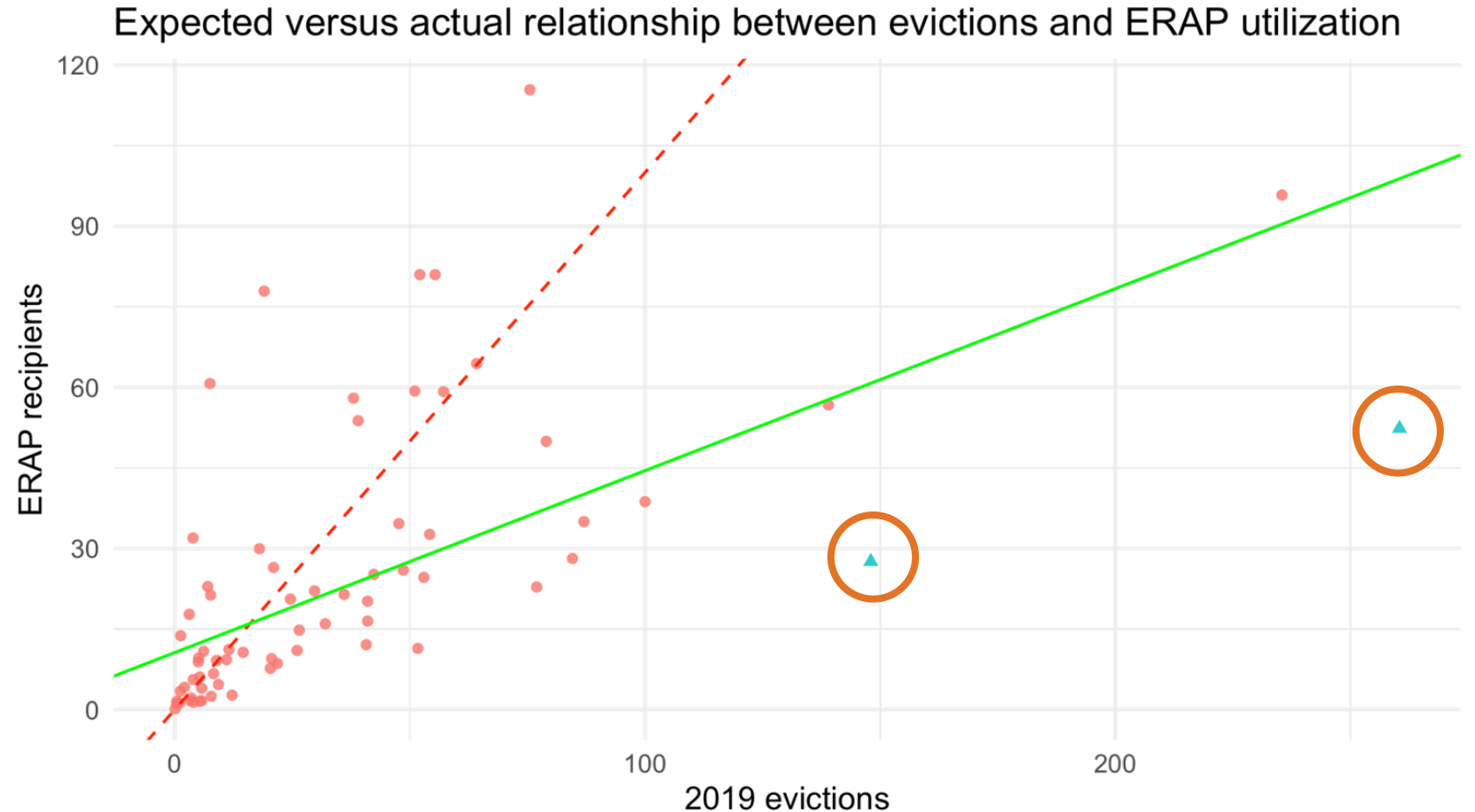
Most evictions are on the west side of the city, where there are relatively low incomes and higher rents



Foreclosure & Eviction Analysis Tool (continued)

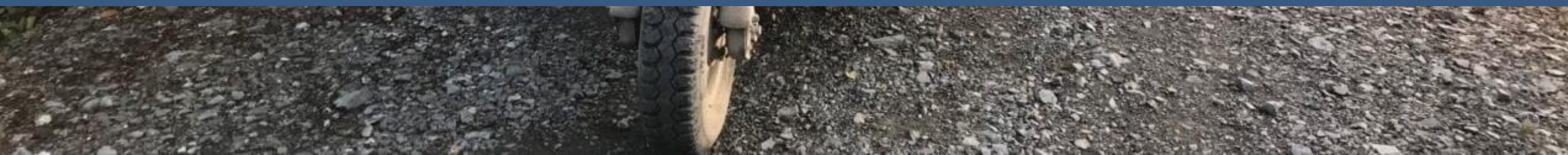
Data compares emergency rental fund utilization and evictions.

The red dotted line shows the 1:1 ratio of evictions and ERAP recipients. The green line is the observed regression line – for most census tracts, need outstrips supply 3:1.

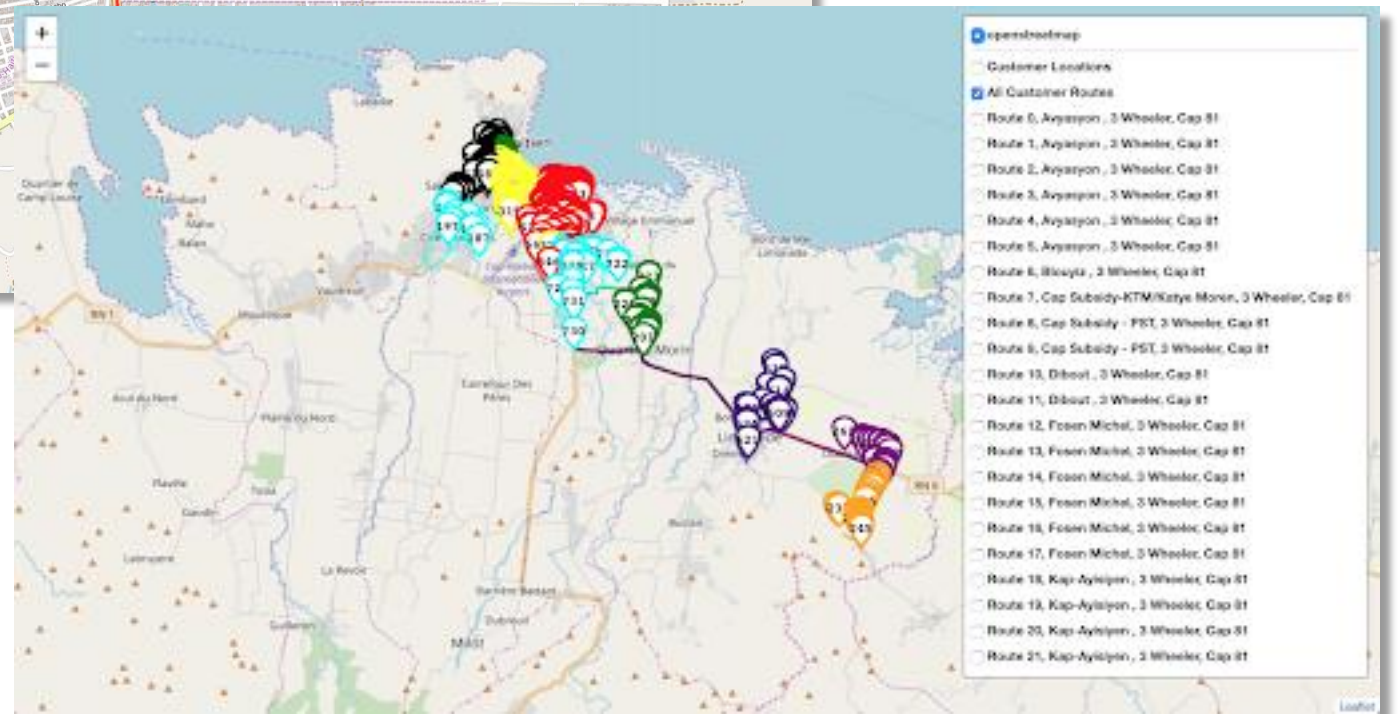
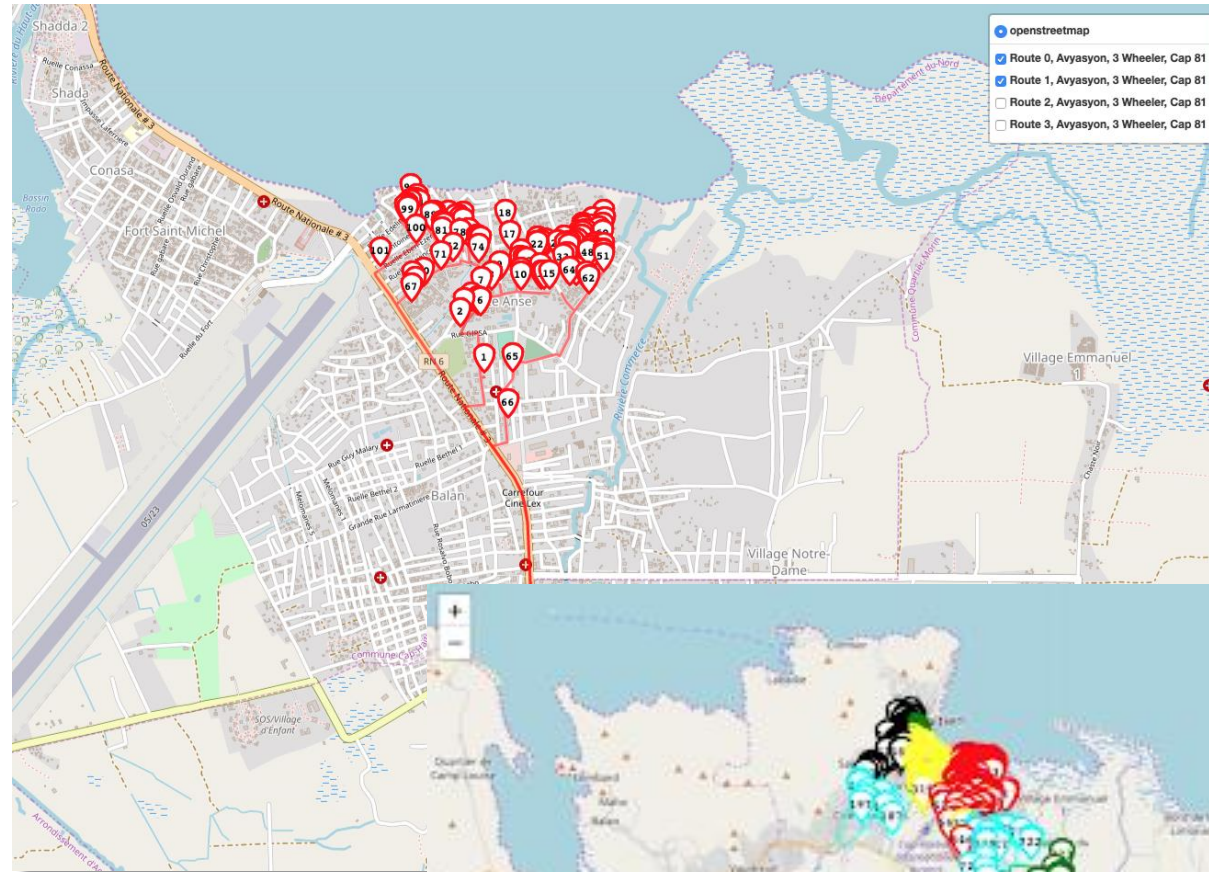


SOIL Haiti

Leveraging open and client data, optimized routes for capacitated vehicles

Produces offline-accessible turn-by-turn directions for drivers & allows for driver customization

SOIL Haiti saved 13% of their previously-spent resources to conduct the same number of trips

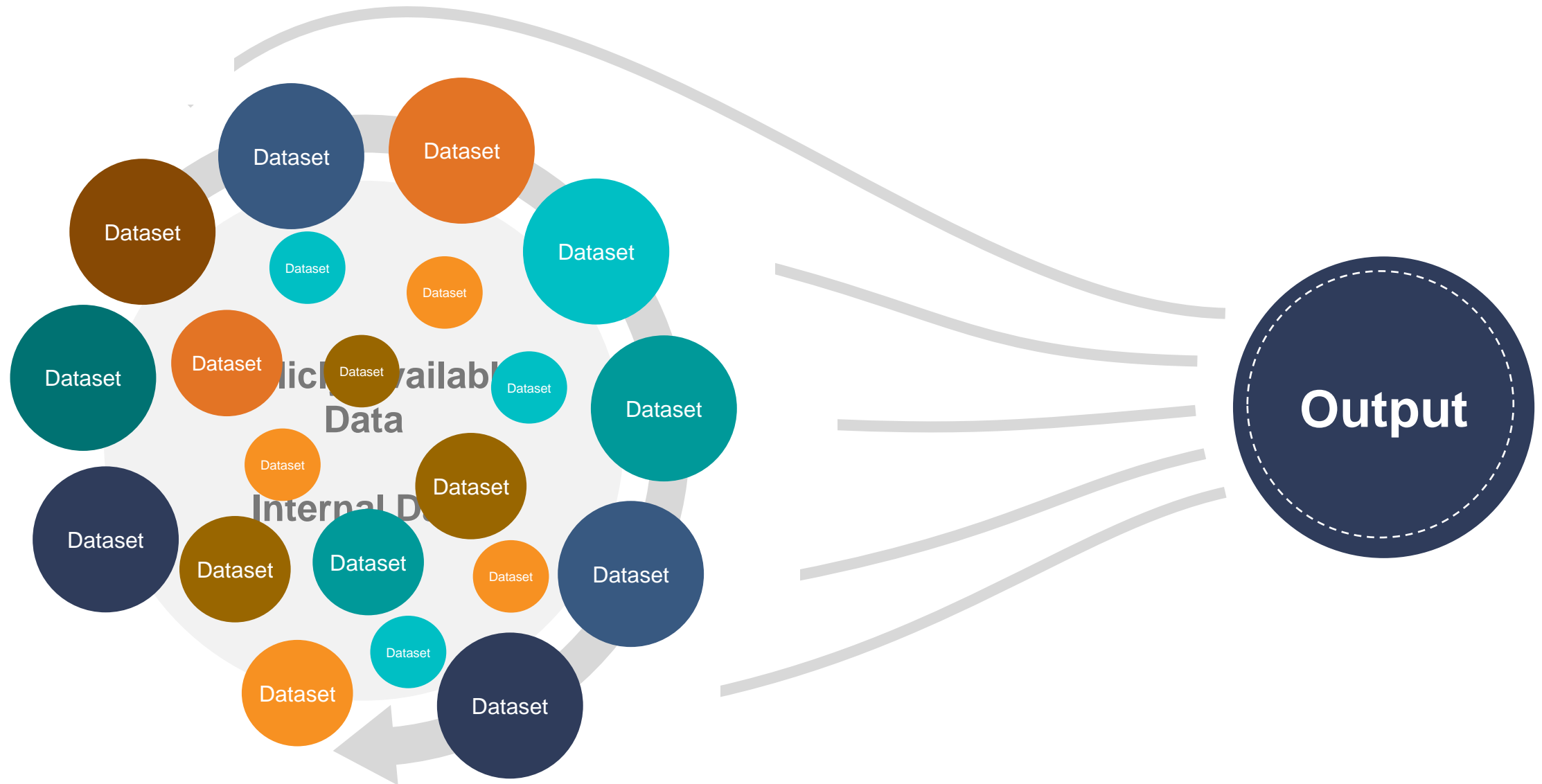
